### Structure your stories faster with the Add-In for PowerPoint - \$5 off for attendees!



During the seminar I described how you can write your script using a Word document. Another option is to write your story completely within PowerPoint using a unique Story Editor included in the Sociable Media PowerPoint Add-In. When you're done writing, simply click a button and you have an instant, pre-formatted storyboard. I worked with NetCentrics, an experienced Microsoft developer, to incorporate many of the ideas in *Beyond Bullet Points* into the Add-In to save you time.
